In the process of establishing God's kingdom in the Nation India, the Lord is raising an Army to fight for His kingdom against satan and his kingdom. Congratulations on dedicating yourself to register your name to be the frontline warrior of The Army of Jesus. As you know,

1. Duties of Individual Soldiers

- 2. Attending or Conducting weekly Troop Church*
- 3. Proclaim the Gospel daily to at least two persons directly or through mail, phone.
(Introducing Jesus to two new persons or motivating 2 believers/Christians with the manna verse for the day.)*
- 4. Start a new troop in 2 months.*
- 5. Trans India programme*

Duties of the members during Troop Church gathering

All the 10 soldiers have a role to play, each one to perform one of the following in turns:

| 8. Planning for the next week etc. | 5 min |
| 9. Concluding prayer (Ps 144:1) | 5 min |
| 10. Preparing Report & sending | 5 min |

During the time of sharing, the Troop Leader should make each one share invariably and instruct them about the duties of individual soldiers mainly their personal prayer (2.30 hours).
